Welcome back and Happy New Year to you all!!

#### Just a few reminders:

• **TERM TIME HOLIDAYS** If you wish to take your child on holiday during term time then please note: Cheshire West and Chester Council will issue a Fixed Penalty Notice. You must complete a holiday request form (available from the school office) which we will then review. Holidays are only granted if the circumstances of the requested leave are 'exceptional'. If they are not deemed as 'exceptional', and you still choose to take a holiday with your child during this period (meaning the absence is classed as unauthorised), the Local Authority will be informed. A Fixed Penalty Notice will then be issued in accordance with section 444 of the Education Act 1996. This will lead to a charge of £60 per child per parent.

• **STAFF CAR PARK** Please do not park in the staff car park at any time. The school carpark is only to be used by our staff. Please do not use this space for health and safety reason with our reception children using the main doors at pick up and drop off times.

• **ABSENCE** If your child is off poorly or absent for any reason then you must inform the school office before 9am. If your child is off for longer than one day, please leave a message daily. Please leave a message on the pupil absence line (option 1).

• **MEDICATION** If your child requires medication during school hours, please hand this in to the school office and complete a medication form. We will not administer any prescribed medication without the correct box and information. If your child is asthmatic, please ensure we have up-to-date inhalers.

• **HEADBUMPS** If your child bumps their head/face during the school day we will send you either a text, smart message or email to inform you stating how it happened and what first aid was carried out. This is not to alarm you but more as a courtesy message so that you can continue to monitor your child at home and seek medical advice if required.

• LOST PROPERTY Please ensure that your child's name is clearly marked on items such as coats, jumpers and cardigans. If your child loses an item then please search the lost property bin in the school hall at the end of the day. We have so many garments not being claimed. We will keep for upto a month but then we will put in recycling if there is no name.

**CHINESE NEW YEAR** We will be celebrating Chinese New Year on January the 23rd here in school. You will see a menu change for this day via school grid Which will include foods like: Sweet and Sour Chicken Egg Fried Rice.



**STAY AND READ** We will be holding a stay and read on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> January. We invite one parents/guardian into the school from 2.30pm to enjoy some reading in the classrooms With their children. Unfortunately, this will not be including our year 5 children this time due to them being at forest school on Thursdays.
