Dear Parents/Carers

I would like to say a huge congratulations to all of our year 6 pupils. We have had 100% attendance from every pupil coupled with 100% effort and determination. We are all so very proud. Well done year 6!

SCHOOL BUS Due to an unexpected, early recall of our minibus, we are only going to have one minibus as of Monday 15th May. This will affect the timings of our before and after school runs. We will be continuing to run two bus trips, however they will run back to back. This may affect your pick up or drop off time. You should have received a text with your new pick up/drop off times. You must ensure your child is at the pickup point 10minutes before your allocated times, this will cater for any children who have text the bus in the morning that they are not in that day and also traffic (we can't judge the traffic, sometimes its busier on the roads, sometimes its quiet). Please note we will be trialling these new times for two weeks and may change times again if it is necessary.

YEAR 6 WORKSHOP Year 6 will be making a visit to Rivacre Valley school on Monday to do a workshop around 'snaptrap'. This will be a 50minute performance associated with smart technology such as iPad, phones and laptops. The performance will raise awareness of e-safety looking at how the misuse of devices can negatively impact children.
