Dear Parents

CORONAVIRUS UPDATE Reminder: Parents and carers are reminded that if your child presents with one of the three main symptoms of Coronavirus (https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/symptoms/) we request that you take them for a PCR test; returning them to school after a negative result. If the result is positive your child will have to follow the 10-day isolation rules. We appreciate that coughs and colds are going around but we have to follow Public Health guidance around testing and appreciate your support with this.

Please be reminded that people aged under 18 years and 6 months or who are fully vaccinated will no longer be legally required to isolate if they are a close contact of someone with COVID-19. Instead, such people will be advised (but not legally required) to get a PCR test unless they have had a positive PCR test in the previous 90 days.
