Dear Parents/Carers

COVID UPDATE Please read as a reminder of the most up to date advice and guidance carefully.

- . Adults with the symptoms of respiratory infection, and who have a high temperature or feel unwell, should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people until they feel well enough to resume normal activities and they no longer have a high temperature.
- . Children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can go back to school, college or childcare when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend.
- . Other Symptoms of covid have been added they include a high temperature or shivering, a new continuous cough, a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste, shortness of breath, feeling tired or exhausted, an aching body, a headache, a sore throat, a blocked or runny nose, loss of appetite, diarrhoea, feeling sick or being sick. The symptoms are very similar to symptoms of other illnesses, such as cold and flu.
- . Adults with positive covid-19 test result should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days, which is when they are most infectious. For children and young people ages 18 and under, the advice will be 3 days.
- . Please encourage your child to cover their mouth and nose with a tissue when they cough or sneeze, and to wash their hands after using or throwing away tissues.
