HOLIDAY AND UNAUTHORISED ABSENCE PENALTIES

As of August 2024, the government is changing the process by which penalties are issued to families for unauthorised absences and holidays during term time. The price of the penalty is also increasing. The official document is currently being produced however the proposed change is

Stage I) The first penalty notice issued to a parent in respect of a particular pupil will be charged at £160 and must be paid within 28 days. This will be reduced to £80 if paid within 21 days.

Stage 2) A second penalty notice issued to the same parent in respect of the same pupil within 3 years of the first notice is charged at a flat rate of £160 and must be paid within 28 days.

Stage 3) A third penalty notice cannot be issued to the same parent in respect of the same child within 3 years of the first penalty. In a case where a third penalty is required, alternative action will be taken instead. This will often include considering prosecution, but may include other tools such as one of the other attendance legal interventions.

The penalties will continue to be issued per child in the family. If you do have any questions please don't hesitate to ask although we may need to wait for the documentation to be officially published before we can answer them.

MHST

The Mental Health Support Team are pleased to share that they have been chosen by the Anna Freud Centre to participate in a national research study focusing on emotional regulation in children (ERiC). As a result, some parents and caregivers of children aged between 6-12 years who Rossmore refer to them, will be invited to participate in this new treatment option. If referred for one of our school based groups, parents/carers may receive a text message from Cheshire and Wirral Partnership NHS Foundation Trust (CWP), followed by a telephone call to discuss treatment options. Details of the treatment and the study will be discussed with parents and caregivers by a member of our team here at CWP in order to obtain consent.
