Dear Parents/Carers

I would like to start the newsletter this week by saying a huge thank you to all parents and children who have really tried hard to wear the correct uniform & PE kit this week. Please do let me remind you all of the main expectations for all pupils.

## UNIFORM

- . Black / grey trousers / skirts
- . White shirt / blouse or polo shirt & tie
- . Red cardigan, jumper or sweatshirt
- . Black shoes / trainers (no bright logos)

- . Plain White T-shirt / polo shirt
- . Plain black sweatshirt / hoodie or red school sweatshirt, cardigan / jumper
- . Plain black jogger pants
- . Plain black trainers / pumps

Can I also remind you about jewellery, Children are able to wear small stud earrings to school but no other jewellery. Playing out at playtime and lunch can be quite boisterous so necklaces and bracelets should **NOT** be worn.

Acrylic and fake nails are also becoming a problem and are not allowed due to health and safety reasons. I would also ask that children with long hair tie it back (helping to create a barrier for the passing of headlice between children)

On a different and more worrying note, it was brought to my attention that some of our parents have taken to parking by or in Reid Court. 
